Wind clockwise until you can feel resistance and stop when you have heavy tension. Over-winding could cause damage. While the number of turns varies from watch to watch, anywhere from 20 to 40 turns should do it. Gently press the stem back to its original position.

Traditional mechanical watches, however, need to be manual wind every one or two days (depending on its power reserve). But as mechanical watch technology matures, there was a demand for an “ automatic ” or “ self winding ” watch.

While an automatic watch is intended to restore its energy by the rotor winding the mainspring through the motion of your arm, it does also require periodic manual winding to keep the mainspring tight. In order to ensure that the crown is not overly strained when you pull it out and wind it, you should take it off your wrist.

How to Wind Your Rolex. Winding is standard procedure for any Rolex with a screw-down crown (which is most of them). It ' s done the same way for all Rolex watches, like so: 1. Unwind the crown by twisting it counterclockwise until it is free of the screw threads. 2. Twist the crown clockwise about 30 times, which will wind the movement of the watch.

Otherwise, to initiate the power reserve, the watch must be wound manually – turning the winding crown in a clockwise direction for around 40 revolutions is usually sufficient for most automatic ...

Is it OK to wind my automatic watch manually with the ...

Wind the watch using the twist and release method. Wind the stem in a clockwise direction, toward the top of the watch and away from your body, one full turn. Continue winding the stem slowly and steadily, until your fingers can go no further. Release the stem, return your fingers to their initial position on the stem and wind again.

Manual-winding watches must be wound by hand every day, whereas self-winding watches are wound by an internal rotor which responds to wrist movements. Self-winding watches usually have a power reserve of at least 40 hours and therefore have sufficient energy reserves to maintain a stable rate when the watch is not being worn (e.g. overnight).
